What is a Cataract?

A cataract is clouding of the natural lens that causes blurred vision. Surgery removes the clouded lens and replaces it with a clear artificial one, called an intraocular lens implant or IOL.

Procedure Details

- Outpatient procedure under IV sedation
- One eye at a time; 2nd eye a few weeks later
- Surgical risk under 1%
- Recovery: 1-2 days per eye

Where & How Long

- NOVA Eye or Fairfax Surgery Center
- Total Time at Center: 2.5 - 3.0 hours
- Surgery on one eye per visit
- Discuss all lens options with your Doctor
- Financing Available

Prepare Your Eyes For Surgery

- Start Artificial Tears - Systane or Refresh 3x/day in both eyes
- Warm Compresses - Apply to eyelids twice daily for 5 minutes each
- Medical Clearance - Schedule with your PCP or cardiologist ASAP

Multi-Vision Without Glasses

Provides distance, computer, & near vision reducing dependence on glasses at most distances.

What is the Expectation?
Reduces or eliminates the need for glasses after surgery

Trifocal IOL
Vision at all distances
Mild halos at night possible

\$3,500 per eye
Astigmatism correction included

EDOF IOL
Distance & Computer vision
Reading glasses for finer print

\$3,500 per eye
Astigmatism correction included

Astigmatism Correction

Reduces Astigmatism, decreasing dependence on glasses for distance vision.

What is the Expectation?
Reading glasses still needed for computer and near vision after surgery

Femtosecond Laser
Uses laser technology to reduce astigmatism with a monofocal IOL

\$1,600 per eye

Toric IOL
Reduces larger amounts of astigmatism not covered by laser alone

\$1,800 per eye

Basic Monofocal

Single Focus giving best approximate "ballpark" distance vision. Does not correct Astigmatism.

What is the Expectation?
Progressive or bifocal glasses needed for all distances after surgery.

Covered Benefit
Monofocal IOL is a covered benefit by insurance
